DISNEY'S FROZEN GETS REGIONAL RESIDENT PREMIERE, DIRECTED BY SESAME STREET VETERAN ALAN MURAOKA

Choreographer Kelly Crandall d'Amboise and Music Director Christopher Youstra are part of a creative team that's among the first authorized by Disney to create a unique staging. Cast led by Alex De Bard, Kennedy Kanagawa, Ricky DeVon Hall, and newcomer Gabriela Hernandez

Olney, MD — September 25, 2024 — Olney Theatre Center, one of the handful of regional theatres chosen by Disney to create their own, original production of *Frozen*, runs the musical October 24, 2024 - January 5, 2025 on the Roberts Mainstage. Written by the Oscar and Tony Award-winning team of Kristen Anderson-Lopez, Robert Lopez (Music and Lyrics) and Jennifer Lee (Book), the international sensation is directed at Olney Theatre by Alan Muraoka, best known as the proprietor of Hooper's Store on *Sesame Street*. This will be the Emmy Award-winning actor and director's third musical at Olney, where he previously directed *Rodgers and Hammerstein's South Pacific* and *Once On This Island*. Local favorite Alex De Bard (*Kinky Boots*) stars as Anna and is joined by rising star Gabriela Hernandez as Elsa, Kennedy Kanagawa (Broadway's *Into The Woods*) as Olaf, and Ricky DeVon Hall (Woolly Mammoth's *Incendiary*) as Kristoff.

The invited press performance is Sunday, October 27 at 7:00 pm (note the earlier curtain time). Interested critics may reserve one or two tickets by emailing sstraub@olneytheatre.org. To accommodate younger audiences, curtain times for this production only will be at 7:00 pm for evening performances and 1:00 pm for matinees.

Says **Artistic Director Jason Loewith**, "It's a great testament to the success we've achieved with our big holiday musicals like **Beauty and the Beast** and **Mary Poppins** that Disney selected Olney Theatre Center to mount the *Frozen's* first resident professional production in the DMV." He continued, "**Alan Muraoka** with, his decades of experience on **Sesame Street**, leads the biggest creative team we've ever put together. Both kids and adults are going to love this new, intimate staging of Disney's smash-hit celebration of sisterhood."

Muraoka has won 2 Emmy Awards for Directing and Producing the iconic television series Sesame Street, where for the past 26 years, he has played Alan, the proprietor of Hooper's Store. His extensive theatrical experience includes performing in 7 Broadway shows and a growing list of directing credits, in addition to South Pacific (2018) and Once On This Island (2014) at Olney Theatre, his work includes: Kafka's Metamorphosis: The Musical!
